Mr. A.K. Rai, learned Additional Chief Standing Counsel and Mr. Rajeev Singh, learned Standing Counsel appear on behalf of respondent nos. 2 to 4.

An application is preferred to have leave to appeal the order dated 3rd December, 2020 passed by learned Single Bench in Writ-C No. 20644 of 2020 directing the office of this Court to necessitate for order sheet in all such matters where prayer for direction for expeditious disposal is made before the authorities.

Leave granted.

Heard learned counsel for the appellant on merits.

We have looked into the general Rules (Civil) as well as the general Rules (Criminal) and also the Allahabad High Court Rules, 1952.

The Rules aforesaid nowhere prescribes for filing the order sheets in each and every case where a direction is sought for expeditious disposal of any matter. A direction given as such is running contrary or is demanding something which not otherwise prescribed under the Rules. In any specific case the Court if consider it appropriate to have order sheets, then it is always open for it to direct the parties concerned to place on

record copies of the order sheets.

In view of whatever stated above, we deem it appropriate to dispose of this appeal by setting aside the direction given by learned Single Bench to the office of this Court.

Appeal is accordingly disposed of.
