1. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

2. This writ petition filed in public interest by a practicing Advocate of this Court has raised a grievance regarding utilization of the passages for to and fro movement by the pass holders of vehicles for whom the parking space in the basement of the building this High court is specified. It is pointed out that leaving the vehicles wrongly parked in the passages has a serious effect upon the ingress and egress of the working Advocates. As a consequence of such a practice, not only that a serious threat is caused to the security but it goes at the cost of a heavy risk to many eventualities which the practicing Advocates may come across.

3. Essentially, the matter pertains to a disciplined behaviour of the Advocates themselves who have been provided a parking facility by the Hon'ble High Court. All such issues in the normal course deserve to be taken care by the Executive Committee of the Bar itself. However, disobedience on the part of the members of the Bar have resulted into a situation that has brought this matter before us.

4. Before responding to the cause by any strict measure, the Executive Committee of the Oudh Bar Association is expected to circulate a notice to all its members practicing in the High Court to park their vehicles at an appropriate space provided for

parking either in the basement or in the multistory parking building. The notice may also spell out the consequences of wrong parking of vehicles whether motor-cars or motor-bikes. At this stage, Security Committee of this Court is required to activate the CCTV Cameras so as to monitor the situation. Any reflection of wrong parking in the CCTV Cameras shall intake a consequence of cancellation of the motor-car/motor-bike entry pass and this position may be brought to the notice of the learned members of the Bar through the notice as directed.

5. Let this exercise be carried out within a period of 15 days' from today.

6. The Bar is also at liberty to circulate such a notice on *WhatsApp* Groups, if any, or through any other mode of publication i.e. social media or print media.

7. List this case on 18.11.2024 as fresh.
