The Court made the following:

ORDER: (per Hon'ble Sri Justice Ravi Nath Tilhari)

The appellant/wife has filed this appeal, challenging the decree of divorce dated 03.07.2024 passed in HMOP No.36 of 2023 by the Court of Civil Judge (Senior Division), Mangalagiri under Section 13(1)(ia) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955. The respondent herein is the husband.

- 2. A perusal of the judgment shows that there was compromise between the parties at the stage of examination of PW.1. The joint memo was filed stating that the matter has been compromised at the instance of the elders and the appellant also received an amount of Rs.4,00,000/- vide Demand Draft No.004523 dated 18.06.2024. She also withdrew the amount on 20.06.2024. Copy of the memo of compromise has been filed along with this appeal. The same was specifically mentioned in the judgment dated 03.07.2024 granting divorce.
- 3. Learned counsel for the appellant does not dispute the said memo, the payment of the amount of Rs.4,00,000/- and the withdrawal thereof by the appellant.
- 4. He does not dispute the compromise. The decree of divorce granted by the learned Civil Judge(Senior Division) being a compromise decree, the present appeal is not maintainable. No appeal lies against the consent decree.
- 5. The C.M.A. is dismissed at the admission stage.
- 6. No order as to costs.
- 7. As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous petitions, if any pending, shall also stand closed.
