UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following O R D E R

- 1. By our Judgment and Order dated 6-3-2025 rendered in the case of "Periyammal (Dead) through LRs & Ors. vs. V. Rajamani & Anr. Etc." Reported in (2025) SCC Online SC 507, we had issued directions as contained in Para 75 as under:-
 - 75. In view of the aforesaid, we direct all the High Courts across the country to call for the necessary information from their respective district judiciary as regards pendency of the execution petitions. Once the data is collected by each of the High Courts, the High Courts shall thereafter proceed to issue an administrative order or circular, directing their respective district judiciary to ensure that the execution petitions pending in various courts shall be decided and disposed of within a period of six months without fail otherwise the concerned presiding officer would be answerable to the High Court on its administrative side. Once the entire data along with the figures of pendency and disposal thereafter, is collected by all the High Courts, the same shall be forwarded to the Registry of this Court with individual reports."
- 2. In pursuance of our aforesaid directions, we have received a consolidated data of the District judiciary of different High Courts regarding the pendency and disposal of various execution petitions.

- 6. The statistics which we have received are highly disappointing. The figures of the pendency of the execution petitions across the country are alarming.
- 7. As on date, 8,82,578 execution petitions are pending across the country.
- 8. In last six months i.e. after our directions, in all 3,38,685 execution petitions have been decided and disposed of.
- 9. Unfortunately, the High Court of Karnataka has failed to furnish us with the necessary data in this regard.
- 10. The Registry shall once again give a reminder to the High Court of Karnataka to furnish the necessary data as regards the disposal of the execution petitions in last six months and the pendency of it as on date.

- 11. The Registrar General of the High Court of Karnataka owes an explanation why he has failed to provide us with the necessary information. Two weeks' time is granted to the Registrar General of the High Court to offer his explanation in this regard.
- 12. In view of the above, we grant further six months to all the High Courts to follow up with their respective District judiciary as regards the disposal of the execution petitions.
- 13. As observed in our main Judgment, after the decree is passed, if it is going to take years and years to execute the decree, then it makes no sense and would be nothing short of travesty of justice.
- 14. We once again request all the High Courts to evolve some procedure and guide their respective District judiciary for effective and expeditious disposal of the execution petitions which are pending as on date.
- 15. Post this matter to report further progress on 10-4-2026.
- 16. On 10-4-2026, we want complete figures from all the High Courts as regards the status of execution petitions the way they have forwarded as referred to above.
- 17. When this matter is notified once again on 10-4-2026, we want all the High Courts on their original side also to furnish the necessary information as regards the pending execution petitions as well as disposal of the same.
- 18. Registry shall forward one copy each of this order to all the High Courts.
