O R D E R

1. Present Special Leave Petition has been filed challenging the impugned judgment and order dated 15th September, 2025 passed by the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad whereby the High Court on the basis of concession/statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner set aside the order of the First Appellate Court and granted temporary injunction.
