Sub:-Regarding constitution and nomination of Members of Monitoring Committee.

Sir,

With due respect, it is submitted that vide letter No. 1149/HCLSC-2026, dated 29.05.2026 of the Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, High Court Allahabad, it has been informed that under the order dated 15.05.2026 of Hon'ble the Chief Justice, the Hon'ble Administrative Committee considered the agenda related to the nomination of Members of the Monitoring Committee as required by Para 8 of the SOP, in the light of the directions in Para No.13 of Order dated 16.04.2026, passed in Criminal Appeal No. 1971/2026 (Arising out of SLP (Crl.) No. 6906 @ Crl. M.P. No. 7862 of 2017, titled as " Shankar Mahto Vs. The State of Bihar" and further submitted that Hon'ble Administrative Committee has been pleased to resolve to constitute the Monitoring Committee of High Court Legal Services Sub-committee, Lucknow and nominated the members as mentioned below :-

In this regard, it is pertinent to mention here that the Monitoring Committee shall perform its functions in accordance with Paragraph 8 of the SOP, specified in Order dated 16.04.2026, passed in Criminal Appeal No. 1971/2026 (Arising out of SLP (Crl.) No. 6906 @ Crl. M.P. No. 7862 of 2017, titled as " Shankar Mahto Vs. The State of Bihar", the relevant extract is reproduced below :-

".....

8.2.2 The tenure of the Members of the Monitoring Committee shall be three years, except the Member Secretary, who shall be ex officio.

8.1.3 The HCLSC/SCLSC shall share the data regarding the marking of matters and progress of filing of matters with the Monitoring Committee on a weekly basis.

8.1.4 The Monitoring Member Committee shall meet at least on a fortnightly basis virtually or physically to review the progress of the matters and will be responsible for issuing necessary recommendations to the HCLSC/SCLSC Member Secretary to maintain the efficiency of the system.

8.2 Committee Functions:

8.2.1 Monthly reviews of progress, delays, and compliance.

8.2.2 Monitor the compliance of timelines set above.

8.2.3 Performance evaluation of lawyers, translators, and jail staff.

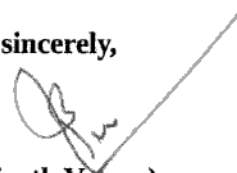

- 8.2.4 Recommend actions: Warnings, training, or removal for defaults.
- 8.2.5 Investigate complaints within 15 days.
- 8.3 Reporting:
- 8.3.1 Monthly reports to SCLSC/NALSA in a standardised format.
- 8.3.2 Annual consolidated report highlighting trends and recommendations.
