*In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the  
Constitution, the Governor is pleased to make the following rules regulating the  
retirement on superannuation of the Judicial Officers:*

1. **Short title and commencement.**- (1) These rules may be called the  
Uttar Pradesh Judicial Officers (Retirement on Superannuation) Rules,  
1992.  
  
(2) They shall come into force with effect from the date of their publication in  
the Gazette.
2. **Overriding effect.**- The provisions of these rules shall have effect  
notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in Rule 56 of the  
Uttar Pradesh Fundamental Rules, contained in the Financial Handbook,  
Volume II, Parts II to IV or any other rules made by the Governor under  
the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution or orders, for the time being  
in force.
3. **Definitions.**- In these rules unless the context otherwise requires:-
  - (a) "Government" means the State Government of Uttar Pradesh;
  - (b) "Governor" means the Governor of Uttar Pradesh;

(c) "*Judicial Officer*" means a member of the Uttar Pradesh Higher Judicial Service or the Uttar Pradesh Nyayik Sewa or the Uttar Pradesh Judicial Officers Service.

4. **Retirement.**- A Judicial Officer shall retire from service on superannuation in the afternoon of the last day of the month in which he attains the age of sixty years.
